Who are we?

The Barnardo's Time for Me project helps and supports children and young people who are affected by someone within their family who misuses drugs or alcohol.

The main aim

The main aim of the programme is to promote and encourage families to move forward following the impact of parental alcohol misuse.

The programme offers families the opportunity to receive support where alcohol misuse has or still is impacting upon their lives.

Steps Together encourages and supports the child to share their personal experience giving them an opportunity to be heard.

Families are encouraged to recognise and reflect on the harm caused by alcohol misuse with a view to work towards personal short and long term goals.

Our Goal

We aim to strengthen relationships, promote new beginnings and encourage families to move forward together.

We aim to promote self confidence, independence and encourage parents to feel empowered enabling them to make informed choices.

What do we do?

Steps Together provides interventions that are structured and relevant to the programme, for families who live within the Dudley Borough with children aged from 8 – 18 years.

- Once a referral has been processed a home visit will be arranged to explain in detail about the programme.
- An assessment will be completed to identify the families situation and needs.
- Workers will provide appropriate support to the parent, child and concerned others.
- There will be an opportunity to attend a social occasion to enable families to meet one another prior to the away day taking place.
- Transport will be provided to take families to a therapeutic and tranquil setting where the away day will take place.
- Steps Together programme is provided free of charge.
