The Youth Club sessions take place on a Monday in Halesowen and a Wednesday in Lye from 6.30pm until 9pm. The sessions are aimed at young people aged between 13 to 25 years. There is a timetable of activities that differ from week to week. These include sports, arts and crafts, pool and darts tournaments, cooking sessions and much more. These sessions are run in partnership with Dudley youth service.

Family Support

We currently have 2 family support sessions. At each session there are different activities for the children to participate in, along with various other forms of play to engage in. All sessions are run by experienced, trained staff.

Tuesdays 4:30pm until 6:30pm This session is an afterschool club and is suitable for children aged between 10-15 years.

Fridays 4:15pm until 6.00pm . This session is an afterschool club and is suitable for children aged between 5-10 years.

We ask for a donation of £4 for each session to support activities.



Transitions

Our transitions group runs every Monday from 6pm to 8pm,. This is aimed at Young People aged 14-24 years old. There are currently different activities taking place each week that the young people have chosen. These activities may change term to term depending on the requirements of the young people. Activities that have been chosen to date are : Bowling, Swimming, cooking, Karate lessons, travel training and a film nights. Some of the activities are held at the Orchard Centre.

The cost of each session is £5.

Home Care Service

Charges for the Home Care Service vary depending on the individual care and will differ for day or overnight care. Examples of the support that we can provide are as follows:

- Morning support, getting your child/young person up , showered and dressed for school.
- After school care.
- Bed time routines
- Overnight care, waking nights and carrying out personal care

We can provide flexible support packages that will suit the individual young person and their family needs and interests

Direct Payments Service

The current cost of the Direct Payments service is from £15 per hour. We offer fully trained competent staff, who can also offer additional support as required.

The service provides:

- One to one support to widen leisure, social opportunities and to access other services.
- Support with life skills and independent travel
- Home based support such as short breaks, personal care, respite or sitting services.
- 1:1 Support at group and inclusive activities

We also have use of the Kids orchard centre facilities depending on its availability from where we can offer cooking or games sessions or just a space to chill out.
