What activities do you do?

Our youth centre has a range of activities, which are available to everyone who attends. Such as pool table, access to an outdoor playing area, arts & crafts, I.T. suite, dance machine, soft play & sensory room and much more! Young people are part of the planning of our activities. We have a members committee who plan the activities and take suggestions for any concerns. We also arrange many day trips and holiday activities. Our young people are also encouraged to take part of accredited activities to enhance their learning if they want to.

All our activities are adapted to meet the needs of the young people in order for them to participate.





We are presently working towards the me2 award which is a Kite-mark for inclusive services. As such we are making sure that all of our facilities and activities are inclusive and adapted to suit the needs of the individual. Our staff are also attending a series of training courses to make sure that we can support our members appropriately.

Russells Hall Neighbourhood Centre have already adapted their centre to meet the needs of children and young people with disabilities. Our building has already achieved the Me2 Award.
